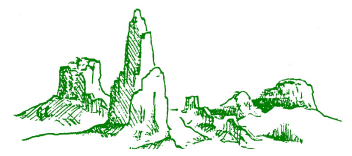

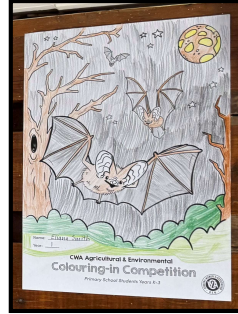

The children have been very interested in all sorts of 'machines' this term, so we have been exploring 'machines', big and small, and work inside and outside. We've also built lots of machines with constructions and at the busy table with box construction items. Many friends also drew 'maps' of their machines before they create them. Amazing thinking and engineering has been occurring.

We had a lot of fun in the sandpit with our 'machines', including the diggers, tractors and trucks – everyone has been harvesting here. Inside, the farm has also been busy with friends spraying and harvesting crops and feeding bales of hay (small cube blocks) to the stock using the big wooden trucks to transport the loads of hay. The conversations between our 'farmers' have been really interesting to listen to. Our farming future is in good hands.

Friends have been busy doing lots of matching at the lotto games, problem solving with the new challenging puzzles and experimenting with the magnets. We've also had plenty of fun at the dress-ups, with many great outfits to choose from, after Miss Marie's Mum's big 'sewing spree'. It was exciting opening up the parcel to see what was inside!

We enjoyed learning all about different types of machines, which culminated in a wonderful excursion on Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> of November to the Gilgandra Rural Museum. Thanks to Craig (who drove Robin's bus) for taking us and to our parent helpers, Kathryn and Jen, for joining us on such a special day.

We had a lovely visit: finding the old Tooraweenah Gaol, the Uargon School, up the road from Oscar's house, and the blacksmith's shop from Hannah's family farm. We looked at lots of interesting things outside, including the man (statue) on the toilet, different windmills and machines in the outside

sheds and in the paddock, before going into the huge shed to see the 'old tractors'. Our preschool friends were allowed to wander throughout this shed at their leisure and discover things, remembering to keep their fingers off/ out of machines, because they still work. Joe's advice to everyone "Don't put your fingers in silly places". Everyone was very careful and responsible, and totally fascinated with so much in this shed.

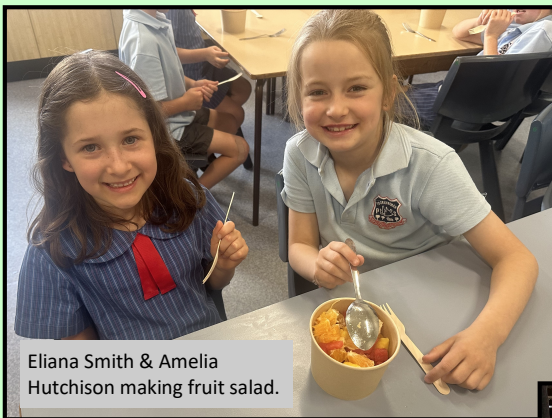
