

SPORTING ROLL OF HONOUR – SELECTION CRITERIA

Objective

To establish eligibility criteria for selection to Council's Sporting Roll of Honour

Scope

Gilgandra sportspersons who meet the criteria set out below

Policy

That the following criteria be used to determine the eligibility of a sports person to be selected on to Council's Sporting Roll of Honour:

1. Through expertise and performance in a duly accredited selection process, gain selection in a representative team which is regarded as "The Australian Team" or "The State Team".
2. Be selected by an accredited National body of a sport, to individually represent Australia in International competition or New South Wales in Australian Competition.
3. Be appointed by a National or International body, to act as a referee, umpire, judge, coach, manager, or other official, for an International sporting event.
4. Be recognised as the "State Champion", "The Australian Champion" or "International Champion" in any nationally recognised sport.
5. Be a resident of Gilgandra prior to, or during State, National or International selection or status was reached prior to being a resident of Gilgandra.
7. Be recognised as contributing outstanding service to Gilgandra sport, even if State, National or International status reached before becoming a Gilgandra resident.
8. Be eligible if residing outside the boundaries of the Shire of Gilgandra, but representing Gilgandra or a Gilgandra team.
9. Be approved by the Selection Committee at their discretion, even if nominees do not meet any of the above criteria.
10. Be a Team representing at State Representative level or higher or regarded as State or National Champions in an accredited sport.
